אָבִינִי מַלְכֵנוּ, חַדָּשׁ עֲלֵינוּ שְׁנָה טוֹבָה. Avinu Malkeinu, chadeish aleinu shanah tovah.

Avinu Malkeinu, bring us a good new year.

אָבִינִי מַלְכֵנוּ, סַלַח וּמַחַל לְכָל עֲוֹנוֹתֵינוּ. Avinu Malkeinu, slach um'chal l'chol avonoteinu.

Avinu Malkeinu, forgive all our sins.

אָבִינִי מַלְכֵנוּ, כְּתֹבֵנוּ בְּסֵפֶר חַיִּים טוֹבִים. Avinu Malkeinu, kotveinu b'sefer chayim tovim.

Avinu Malkeinu, write us down in the Book of Good Life.
