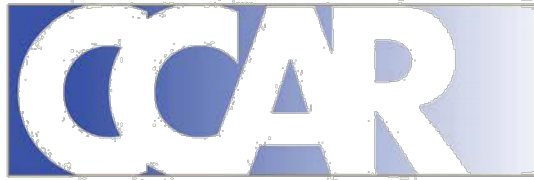




## YOM KIPPUR MORNING CUES- 2017

	Briefly explain the book- white page- trad text, gray shade- alternative, blue shade- reflection and study (sometimes silent and sometimes in dialogue with those near you); selections – the diversity of who Jews are today and what they believe- turning of pages to embrace all of you; Follow along and let eyes wander; Much will be familiar and much will be new- readings and music
